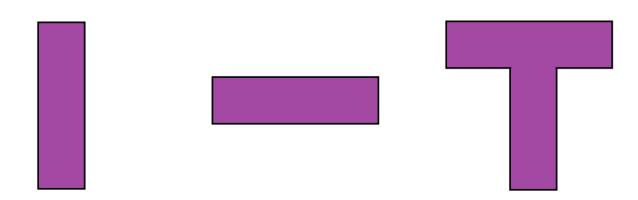

- Foster collaboration between the customer and developers by gaining consensus on a bill of rights and responsibilities for each side in the relationship.
- Those doing the work have the sole right to estimate the work, while the customer has the exclusive right to prioritize it.



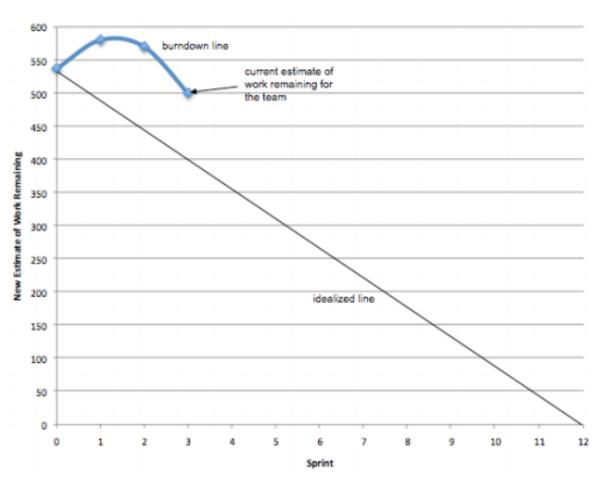




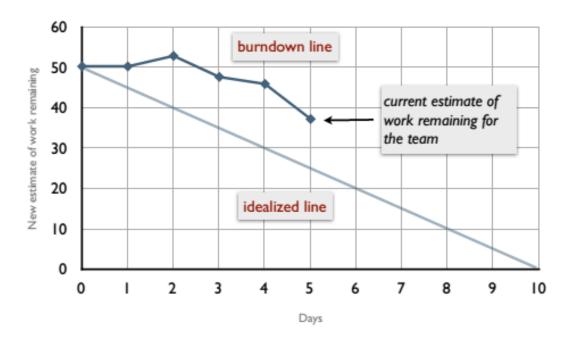
- Nurture a culture in which experimentation & learning are embraced;

- Create an organizational structure that reinforces and rewards the other two dimensions.

Sprint burndown

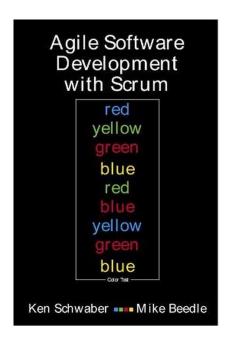


Release Burndown Chart.

The Product Board - Personas

Rebecca's story

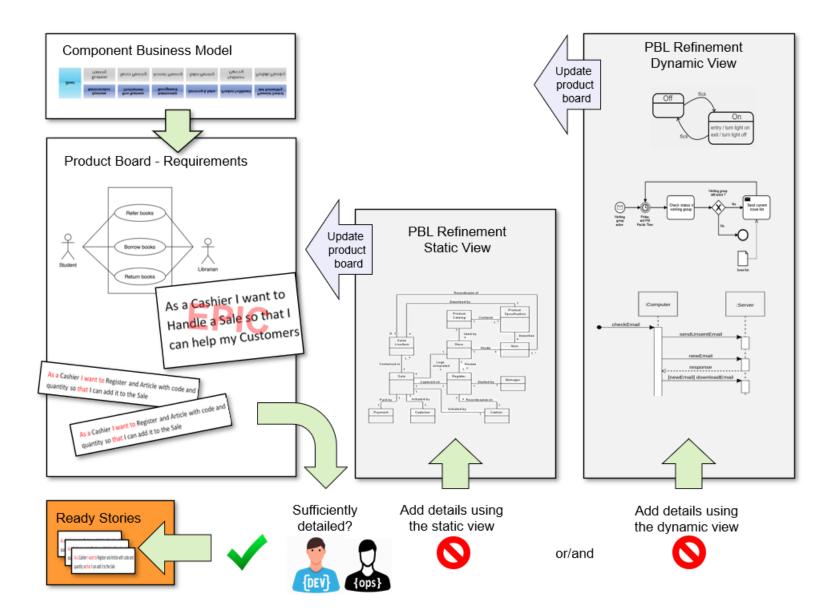
Music is a big part of my life; I like to think that I always have a "background music" running in each scene of my life. I love working while listening to music; somehow, it gives me a lot of focus on my task.

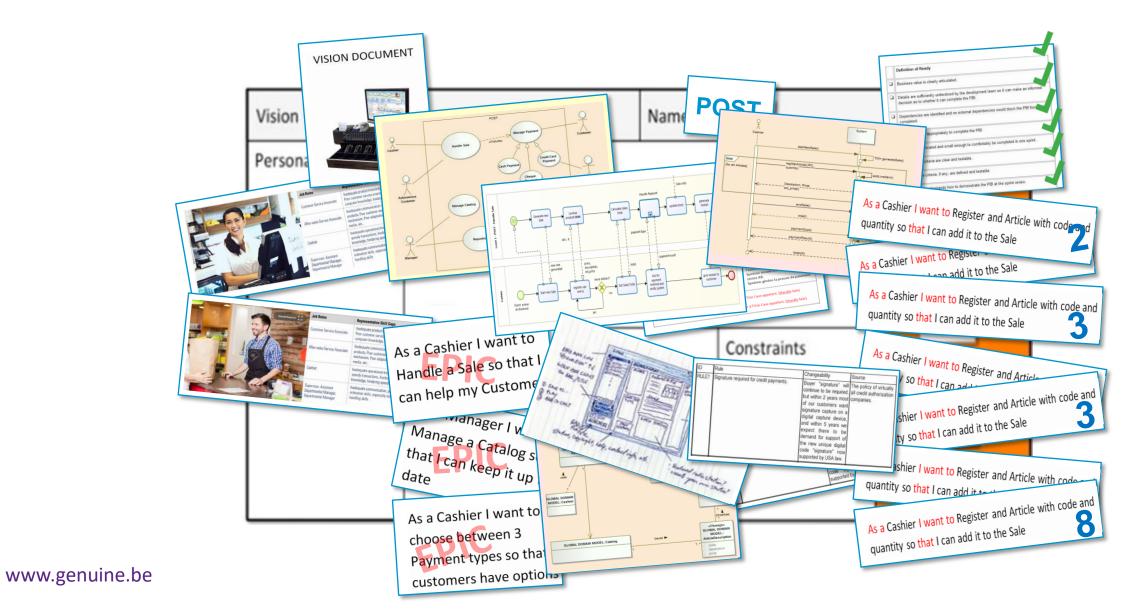

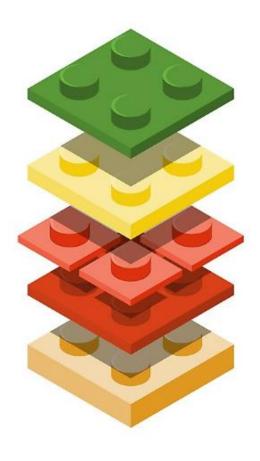

What does Agile mean for Business Analysis?

- Refinement of acceptance criteria and development of test cases
- Development of wireframes, low-fidelity, and high-fidelity prototypes
- Elicitation and feedback—including one-on-one and group interviews, job shadowing etc.
- Research of existing documentation, updating the product board
- Requirements analysis, including specification of inputs and outputs, data verification rules, business rules analysis, process analysis, and data modelling
- Monitoring progress of tasks and stories
- Story testing and validation during the code-build-test-deliver cycle
- Managing scope changes after the iteration begins
- Requirements tracing
- Epic, feature, and story preparation

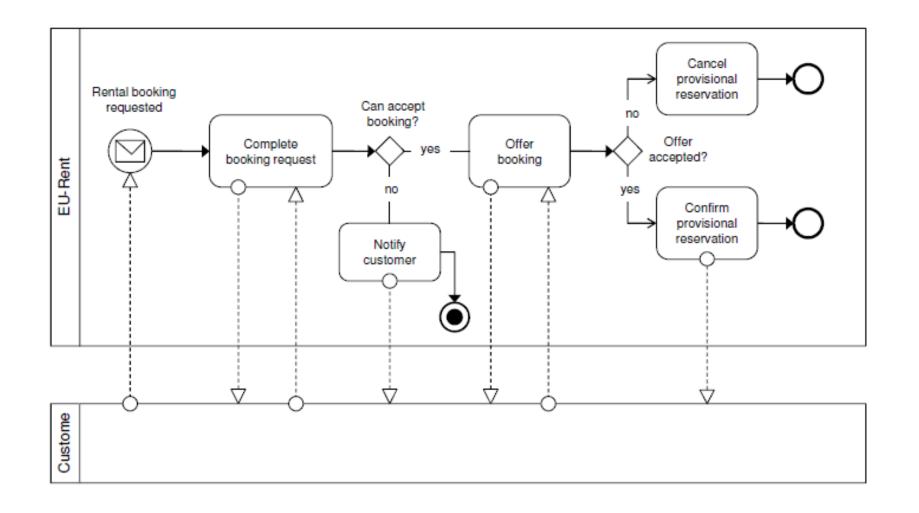
